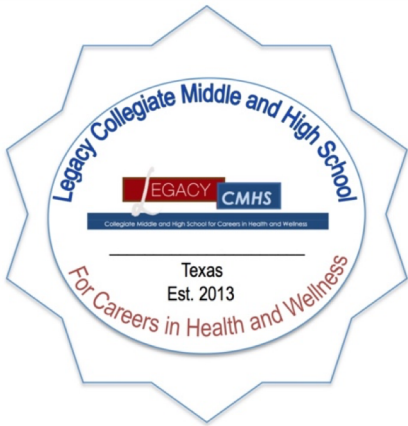


## High school | Grades 9-12
